Advanced Scientific Internships

The Doctorate Scientific Advanced Internship is an individual work programme in the areas of Educational Sciences and Child Studies, developed under the supervision of a Ph.D. holder at IE as part of an ongoing doctoral programme at another national or foreign higher education institution, where the doctoral student has his/her own supervisor.

Target audience: Students of doctoral programmes at other national or foreign higher education institutions.

Duration: one to twelve months. **Regime:** Tutorial **Applications:** At any time of the year

Post - Doctorate

The Post-Doctorate is an individual research programme for external researchers to further develop their former Ph.D. studies under the scientific supervision of a Full or Associate Professor, a Principal/Lead Researcher or a Senior Researcher at the Institute of Education.

Target audience: Teachers and Ph.Ds holders, national or foreign, that fit into the scientific fields of the Institute. **Duration:** : six to thirty six months **Regime:** Tutorial **Applications:** At any time of the year

SIn-service Teacher Training Actions - The available training actions fall under the following modalities of the Legal Regime for the Continuing Teacher Education: Training Course (25 hours - 1 credit); Training Module (20 hours -0.8 credits); Training Workshop (50 hours, 25 of which in a face-to-face format - 2 credits).

Short-Term Actions - The Office for Interaction with Society of the Institute of Education (GIS-IE) accredits seminars, conferences, thematic workshops or other scientific and pedagogical events as short-term courses when they have a minimum duration of $\vec{3}$ hours and a maximum duration of 6 hours.

Short Courses - Short courses are courses that, although they may be structured in modules, aim at developing specific technical, professional or cultural competencies, in a logic of initial or continuing education. These courses can be credited by the University (with less than 15 credits) or non-credited. The credited short courses available at IE are Enhancement Courses for graduates, ranging from 7.5 to 13.5 ECTS.

Single Course Units

Students can enrol in one or more course units of a master's degree, within the scope of an exceptional regime. The successful conclusion of course units of the Academic Master's degrees in this regime may be accredited for In-service Teacher Training purposes. The request to join this regime should be made at the Academic Services of the University of Minho up to 30 days before the beginning of classes.
